

House Rules MECC Parties

- Visitors are required to show valid ID and Student Identity Card (SIC) if requested.
- Visitors may be searched prior to or during the event or they will be denied access.
- It is not permitted to carry (hard) liquor or dangerous objects (such as weapons, fireworks, bats, aerosols, sprays, tins, glass etc.) or food. These will be confiscated and will not be returned.
- It is not allowed to have or drink alcoholic beverages <18 years.
- It is not permitted to carry professional (digital) cameras, cameras with a lens >70 mm, video- and / or sound equipment.
- Objects may –in some circumstances- be stored and will be returned when leaving the venue, all at the discretion of organization and/or security.
- It is not permitted to take animals or bicycles to the location or venue.
- Visitors must follow instructions of the organization and/or security or be denied access.
- Visitors are to ensure public order and safety are not jeopardised (in any way), or they will be denied access.
- Trade in, and use or possession of soft- and / or hard drugs are not permitted. These will be confiscated and not returned. Owners will be handed over to the police.
- Vehicles / bicycles are to be parked in the designated spaces only. Wrongly parked vehicles / bicycles may be removed. The organization cannot in any way be held responsible for any damages caused by the removal of these wrongly parked vehicles / bicycles.
- The organization is not liable for any loss or theft of personal property.
- Visitors who cause damage to properties of the INKOM/MECC/INKOM-locations will be held responsible for all costs and will be reported to the police.
- The organization is not liable for sound levels which could cause hearing damage.
- It is not permitted to smoke at the indoor locations. Smoking is allowed only in designated areas.
- Photos or videos of visitors may be shown on a 'public source' (such as internet, social media etc.).
- If a visitor is denied access, entry fees will not be refunded.
- In situations not covered by house rules, decisions are at the organization's discretion. The organisation's decision is final.
